



The International Tribunal for Natural Justice has established a historic Commission to examine how a series of 15th-century papal bulls became the foundation of global colonization and continue to affect Indigenous peoples worldwide. This inquiry traces a two-millennia transformation: how an anti-imperial Judaic renewal movement was systematically co-opted by Roman strategy and evolved through Christian institutional development into the most comprehensive system of global domination ever devised.

#### **Why This Matters Today**

Contemporary legal systems still operate on medieval foundations. Supreme Court cases continue citing Discovery doctrine precedents, multinational corporations invoke these principles to justify resource extraction on Indigenous lands, and international law privileges European-derived state structures over Indigenous governance systems. The Vatican's 2023 "repudiation" was largely symbolic—the doctrine remains embedded in secular legal frameworks worldwide as apparently neutral law.

#### **Our Two-Track Approach**

**Expert/Context Track:** This track establishes the institutional foundation showing how systematic dispossession was not historical accident but the logical outcome of strategic transformation spanning two millennia. Commissioners and expert witnesses will trace the complete genealogy: from Roman co-optation of Christianity, through medieval institutional development and papal territorial grants, to Protestant secularization and modern legal embedding. This includes examining how corporate legal innovations—from medieval Church corporate personality to Dutch East India Companies—enabled institutional control across vast territories and time periods.



First Nations Testimony Track: This track centres Indigenous voices and authority, providing a platform for First Nations peoples globally to share their testimonies about the lived impacts of this institutional framework. Rather than treating Indigenous experiences as isolated grievances, this track restores Indigenous peoples as the primary authorities on their own experiences while documenting how the same systematic framework has affected cultures, languages, lands, waters, and communities across continents. These testimonies will demonstrate the continuing effects of institutional dispossession and highlight Indigenous resistance, resilience, and solutions.

#### **The Complete Timeline:**

**Roman Strategic Acquisition (1st-5th centuries):** Transformation of an anti-imperial Jewish movement into imperial ideology Medieval Institutional Development (8th-14th centuries): Creating comprehensive legal architecture through forged documents, corporate innovations, and systematic theological frameworks

Colonial Implementation (15th century): Papal bulls deploying two millennia of institutional preparation for global conquest Protestant Adaptation (16th-18th centuries): Secularizing Catholic colonial frameworks while preserving essential colonial benefits Modern Legal Embedding (19th-21st centuries): Discovery doctrine embedded in contemporary legal systems as apparently neutral law how corporate legal innovations—from medieval Church corporate personality to Dutch East India Companies—enabled institutional control across vast territories and time periods.



#### **Commission Authority**

Operating under ITNJ's mission to "apprehend abuses of systems and institutions; restore truth and reason to justice delivery; uphold natural law," this Commission has authority to conduct research, convene public hearings, and compel document production through lawful due process. The Commission operates independently, free from political interference, with full transparency and accountability.

#### **Expected Impact**

This inquiry will provide the institutional understanding necessary for meaningful decolonization. By documenting the complete genealogy from Roman strategy to contemporary legal systems, the Commission will demonstrate why surface-level legal changes are insufficient—genuine reform requires addressing foundational assumptions embedded over two millennia. The Commission's findings will inform legal challenges, educational curricula, and policy recommendations while honouring Indigenous sovereignty and self-determination.

#### **Moving Forward**

This Commission represents a unique opportunity to examine one of history's most enduring institutional frameworks. By combining rigorous historical analysis with Indigenous testimony, we can provide the tools necessary for communities and institutions to address ongoing colonial impacts with the depth and sophistication this work requires. Understanding this complete trajectory is essential for developing effective strategies to challenge colonial logic and achieve genuine justice. The Commission seeks to honour Indigenous voices while providing the institutional analysis necessary to understand how two millennia of systematic development created frameworks that continue affecting Indigenous peoples worldwide.

The International Tribunal for Natural Justice was established in 2025 in Westminster Central Hall in London on the 800th anniversary of the signing of the Magna Carta. Sacha Stone, Chief Justice Sir John Walsh of Brannagh, Justice Chris Cleverly and Commissioner Lewis Montague were joined by thousands of people across the globe via livestream for the ceremonial seating and the formalising of the court - established in order to give a voice to the voiceless.







Founder of the International Tribunal for Natural Justice - Sacha Stone, was asked in Spring of 2016 by Commissioner Lina Helstein to address a Lithuanian special parliamentary committee on the serious issue of Governmental Corruption and to work with a select group of Justices and Parliamentarians in forging a strategic path to investigate their own government. 
